However, a Department of Education and Skills circular states that in the event of unforeseen closures, we may need to open on days we had originally planned to close. These include days in February and around Easter. We encourage parents/ guardians not to make holiday plans for these days in particular, in case we need to remain open.



Due to Covid-19 restrictions, visitors to the school are not permitted unless previously arranged with the Principal or school secretary. All pre-approved visitors must first complete the

Contact Tracing form (QR Code on the front door of the school) and 'submit' it to the Office before entrance to the school building will be permitted. There are strictly NO exceptions to this rule.

Pupil Insurance cover—Each year the school organises insurance cover for parents who wish to avail of it for their child(ren). The cost for 24 hour cover is €10.10 per child. This insurance covers children in the event of an accident, subject to the exclusions and conditions on the application form. May we gently remind parents that the school must send a report to the National Education and Welfare Board regarding absences. We are obliged to send a list of the children who are absent for more than twenty days in the school year to the NEWB. We trust you understand our obligations in this matter.



All reasons for absences, late arrivals, early collections, must be EMAILED to Helen at office@tiermohanns.ie—handwritten notes cannot be accepted.
